## Scheme of Examination and Promotion Policy for Sr. Secondary Department

### Session – 2023-24

The Examination Pattern & Promotion Policy has been designed as per Circular issued by Director of Education vide order No. DE/5/212/Exam/16-17/1373-81 on dated 09/10/2019 in this continuation CBSE reframed of the Examination and Assessment practices from the academic session 2022-23 according to order no. DE/5/212/Exam/16-17/Part-I/365-374 on dated 01/07/2022.

The Academic Session for classes XI and XII has been divided into two terms and in two areas

### 1. Scholastic Area for class XI:

#### a) Term-wise weightage of Marks of Class XI

**The Weightage of marks for class XI –XII will be**

**(i) Periodic Assessment = I, II & III:**

- (1) PT #1 : will be conducted before the Mid Term Examination
- (2) PT#2 & PT#3 : will be conducted before the Pre-Board Examination/Annual Examination
- (3) Duration of each Test : 45 minutes
- (4) Maximum Mark for each Test : 25 Marks

Average marks of best two out of three Periodic Test to be considered for promotion.

**(ii) Subject of Internal Assessment:**

In case of P.H.E., General Studies, Work Experience only grade will be awarded on nine point scale i.e., A1, A2, B1, B2, C1, C2, D1, D2 & E no written test will be held.

## **2. Co- Scholastic Activities for classes XI & XII:**

School should promote co-curricular activities for the holistic development of the student. These activities will be graded on an 8- Point grading scale (A to E). The students shall be assessed on three areas i.e., Health and Physical Education with Work Experience and General Studies.

## **3. Passing Criteria:**

(a) A candidate will be eligible to get pass certificate, if he/she gets a grade higher than E in all subjects of internal assessment i.e., H.P.E/Gen. Studies & Work Experience, unless he/she is exempted.

(b) Subject involving practical work a candidate must obtain 33% marks in theory and 33 % in practical separately, In addition to 33% marks in aggregate in order to qualify in the subject.

(c) Pass marks in each subjects of external examination will be 33% marks to qualify that subject.

(d) No overall division/distinction will be awarded to the students who are promoted.

## **4. Compartment Examination:**

A candidate failing in one of the five subjects of external examination shall be placed in compartment in that subject provided he/she qualifies in all subject of internal assessment.

## **5. Preparation of Annual Result:**

- a. A candidate will be eligible to get pass certificate when he /she clear all external and internal subjects as prescribed in pass criteria.
- b. Weightage of Mid Term and Annual Term will be add according about criteria.
- c. The effect of additional subject will not be substituted in fail subject of class XI. But the preparation will be done for CBSE Board Examination. The teaching of additional subject will be carried out. If the student fail in additional subject must be given improvement exam for promotion to the next class.

- d. In case a student is enable to appear at mid term examination in one or more subject on medical ground issued by a degree holder doctor or due to late admission or participating national/state/international games and sports. The mid Term Exam may be ignore for computation of his/her result and promotion to the next higher class on the basis of only annual examination.
